
Saturday 5 April THE ISLE OF WIGHT




Saturday 19 July GREAT YARMOUTH featuring the Hippodrome Circus and Water Ballet (optional)








Saturday 2 November MARLBOROUGH plus a Wiltshire Pub Lunch



We will also visit **Tewkesbury Abbey** with its stunning Norman architecture and finally enjoy **full afternoon tea** at the famous **Lygon Arms Hotel** in **Broadway**. Our nightaway will therefore include a drive through beautiful Cotswold's scenery.




ITINERARY

Day 1 (Sunday)

Our Bessway coach will travel westwards from London with a stop for **morning coffee** in the Cotswolds at **Burford**. We then visit **Coughton Court** in Warwickshire. From here we shall take a scenic route westwards passing through Cleobury Mortimer and over Clee Hill to arrive in **Ludlow** at the **Feathers Hotel** by about 5.00pm. **Dinner** and an overnight stay.



After breakfast you will have time to explore **Ludlow at leisure**. At 2pm we shall leave Ludlow and travel to **Tewkesbury** to visit the impressive abbey church. This will be followed by **afternoon tea** at the famous **Lygon Arms** in **Broadway**. Finally today we shall travel back to West London where we expect to arrive at Hillingdon Station by 7.30pm and at our other set-down points between 7.45pm and 8.45pm. This brings our nightaway to a close. We hope you will join us on this interesting and varied 2-day short break.



Springtime in Guernsey & Sark Sunday 27 April 2025 for 5 days

Based at the 4 star Moore's Central Hotel in St Peter Port

Our holiday to Jersey in the Channel Islands in 2021 (during the pandemic) was greatly enjoyed. It has resulted in requests that in 2025 we arrange a similar trip to **Guernsey** and **Sark**. Well, here it is! We have reserved bedrooms at the well appointed **Moore's Central Hotel** which enjoys a convenient location in the main shopping street within a short walk of the harbour. A lift serves all floors. This is unquestionably one of Guernsey's finest hotels, not least due to the quality of its cuisine. The itinerary below sets our our plans for each day. We hope you will decide to join us.

ITINERARY

Day 1 (Sunday) From West London, picking up at all of our usual coach pick-up points, we shall travel by Bessway coach to Southampton's fairly small airport at Eastleigh. If you would like a home pick-up by licensed hire car to bring you to Hillingdon Station - to board our coach there - this can be arranged for an extra charge of £8.50 per person each way. During the Southampton journey a **light buffet lunch** will be arranged at a suitably located hotel. Guernsey's airline **Aurigny** is expected to have a flight departure at **3.25pm** (flight GR 1329) which will get us to Guernsey in a mere 45 minutes. Here transport will be arranged to bring us to Moore's Central Hotel in St Peter Port. **Dinner** here this evening.

Day 2 (Monday) A circular tour by coach awaits us this morning when we shall travel clock-wise along Guernsey's coastal road, starting and finishing in St Peter Port. A stop for coffee will be arranged along with visits to Sausmarez Manor and the Little Chapel. Afternoon at leisure. Why not visit Castle Cornet with our tour manager? Dinner at our hotel.

Day 3 (Tuesday) Today we shall visit by taxi Hauteville House on the edge of St Peter Port. It was here that the novelist Victor Hugo lived in exile for 14 years from 1856. The house has an attractive garden with sea views across to France and a truly amazing interior as pictured below. Les Miserables was written here. Rest of day at leisure. Why not visit the fascinating German Occupation Museum with our tour manager? Dinner at our hotel this evening.

Day 4 (Wednesday) A whole day excursion to the Island of Sark departing from St Peter Port harbour at 10.00am, returning from Sark at 5.00pm. On Sark we shall arrange transport from the harbour - a wagon pulled by a tractor - to the village centre. This will be followed by a horse-drawn tour of the island. This afternoon we plan to visit the colourful walled garden at La Seigneurie which is home to the island's administrator. In World War 2 it was the home of the Dame of Sark. Dinner at our hotel.


Day 5 (Thursday) After breakfast we shall return to the mainland by Condor ferry, a 3 hour voyage to Poole. Taxis will take us to the harbour and our Bessway coach will meet us at Poole. A late lunch will be arranged during this homeward journey to conclude our holiday. Cars will meet our coach at Hillingdon (for those having the home pick-up service).
