Day 1 (Sunday)

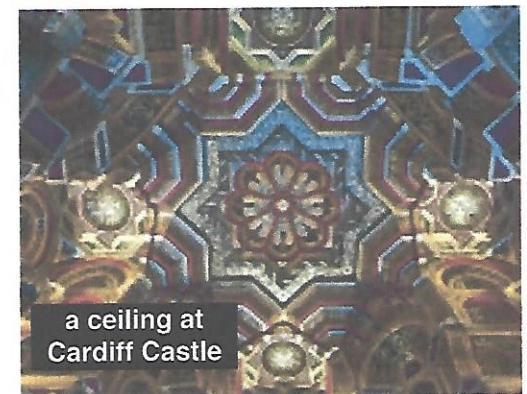
Our Bessway coach will travel westwards from London with a stop for **morning coffee** in Berkshire. We shall then cross the Severn Bridge to arrive at **Cardiff Castle** with its truly amazing interior. Here you can obtain a lunchtime snack in the castle cafe. Finally today we shall travel to **Swansea** to check-in at our hotel, the 4-star **Delta Marriott** overlooking Swansea Bay. **Dinner** and a 3-night stay.

Day 2 (Monday)

Today we shall travel to **Laugharne** on the scenic Taf Estuary which was home to Dylan Thomas, author of *Under Milk Wood*. **Tenby** comes next. With its two bays, beaches and quaint medieval streets this is one of the loveliest places on the Pembrokeshire coast. At the harbour you can take a boat trip to nearby **Caldey Island** (optional) where the Cistercian monks will welcome you and allow you to experience the peace of their very special island. **Dinner** at our hotel this evening.

Day 3 (Tuesday) We shall show you the scenic splendour of the famous **Gower Peninsula** this morning prior to us visiting the **National Botanic Garden of Wales** near Carmarthen. Inside the world's largest single span glasshouse is a mediterranean climate, a 6 metre deep ravine, a stream and waterfalls as well as themed gardens and over 8000 species of plants. **Dinner** at our hotel this evening.
